Client Confirmation Code [XCHK]

The client confirmation code consists of two letters and two numbers telling you the

- gender (Male/Female),
- race (Asian, Black, Hispanic, Native American, White, or Other), and
- the last two digits of the client's year of birth (such as 59 for 1959).

The purpose of this code is to avoid accidental mis-administration since the client's name does not and should not appear on this form.
