SUBSTANCE USE

Chestnut offers a variety of services at its facilities in Illinois for both adolescents and adults including:

- Assessment
- Outpatient
- Intensive Outpatient (IOP)
- Inpatient (Residential)

Our addiction treatment services help individuals work on both addiction issues and mental health concerns at the same time.

MEDICALLY MONITORED DETOX

- Clients experiencing withdrawal from alcohol or other mood altering drugs meeting our admission criteria can safely be detoxified at one of our Crisis Residential units. Detox is overseen by physicians and advanced practice nurses. 24-hour nursing services are provided.



MENTAL HEALTH

CRISIS STABILIZATION

- Chestnut Health Systems provides 24 hour short term supervised care for persons aged 18 years and older experiencing an acute psychiatric crisis who do not require hospitalization.
- The average length of stay is 14 days.

INDIVIDUAL AND FAMILY COUNSELING

- Our trained Masters level and licensed clinicians are available to assess your needs and provide therapy services for all ages. The type and intensity of services depends on the needs of each individual or family.

CHILDREN AND YOUTH SERVICES

- Our services are designed for effective, short term interventions with a variety of difficulties experienced by young people.
- Our treatment staff are experienced in helping families and children cope with such issues as depression and grief, anxiety, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), behavioral problems, family conflict, blended family issues, and serious trauma.



PRIMARY CARE



CHESTNUT FAMILY HEALTH CENTER (CFHC)

CFHC is a community-based health center that offers adult and pediatric primary care to residents of Madison and McLean Counties. The Center believes in preventative medicine and encourages annual physical exams, gynecological care, immunization updates and cancer screenings.

This health center is a Health Center Program grantee under 42 U.S.C. 254b, and a deemed Public Health Service employee under 42 U.S.C. 233(g)-(n).
