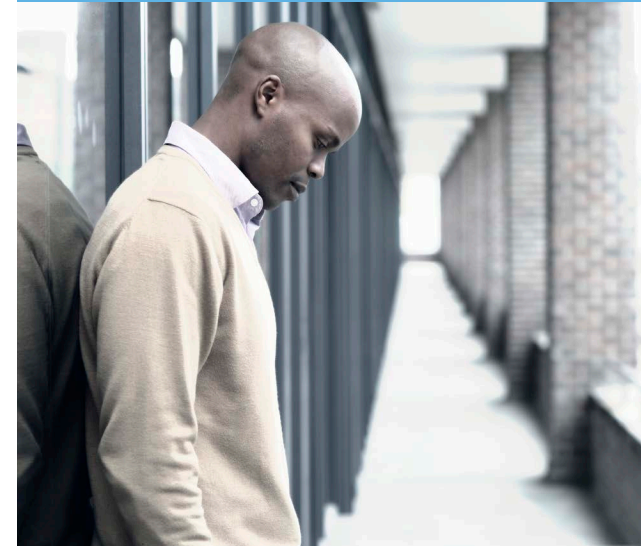

MEDICALLY MONITORED DETOXIFICATION SERVICES

Chestnut Health Systems provides 24-hour short term supervised care for persons aged 18 years and older experiencing a withdrawal from alcohol and/or opiates who do not require acute hospitalization.

Persons may refer themselves for detoxification services or may be referred by hospitals, police departments, mental health agencies, social service agencies, and family members.

Length of stay depends on withdrawal symptoms; typically 3-5 days. Chestnut will provide a safe and supportive environment conducive to achieving stability to live a life free of substances.

Admission to our unit is voluntary. The facility is not prepared to work with persons who are experiencing serious medical problems or complications.

THE MEDICALLY MONITORED DETOX PROGRAM HAS THE FOLLOWING COMPONENTS:

Screening and Assessment: People seeking detoxification services must complete a phone screening to determine eligibility for admission to the detox unit. An in-person assessment is then scheduled and completed by nursing staff, preferably within the same business day depending on bed availability.

Medically Monitored Detox Services: People experiencing withdrawal symptoms from alcohol and/or opiates meeting our admission criteria can safely be detoxified. Our unit is staffed with trained nurses, medical assistants and mental health professionals to provide safety and stability during this time of withdrawal.

Each person receiving detoxification services contributes to their recovery by assuming responsibility for tasks including:

- Working with the treatment team to craft goals for one's stay in the CRU and to create a comprehensive discharge plan that will support ongoing recovery and stability.
- Maintaining a peaceful environment.
- Personal care and grooming.
- Maintaining a clean environment, including bedroom and common areas.
- Refraining from using drugs and alcohol.
- Refraining from smoking while on Chestnut property.



PAYMENT

Most forms of payment are accepted. A financial intake is completed upon day of admission. Various payment options are offered. Admission is subject to a prior authorization with some insurance companies.
